Brevard College Music Audition Information and Instructions

All students wishing to major in music or earn a performance scholarship must audition for the faculty prior to entering Brevard College. For highest scholarship potential, plan to audition no later than April 1, 2018.

Repertoire requirements:

All students should prepare two contrasting solo selections (single movement or song/aria). Instrumentalists should also be prepared to play scales and sight-read. Voice selections should be performed from memory. Voice auditions may include guided vocalizing and aural recall. An accompanist will be provided for voice auditions. For specific repertoire questions, please email musicinfo@brevard.edu with your contact name and instrument. Your request will be forwarded to the appropriate applied teacher.

2018 Audition dates:

- Monday, January 15
- Saturday, February 10
- Saturday, March 17 (Instrumental only)

Audition results:

You should receive a letter with your results within three weeks of your audition. In some cases, scholarships are determined at the time of the audition. When this is not the case, scholarship notification will come under separate cover, no later than April 16, 2018.

Awards:

Awards for majors are larger than those for non-majors, and non-major awards come with specific ensemble participation requirements. Award amounts are determined by the strength of your audition, departmental need, and other factors. All students are encouraged to interview for Brevard College Leadership Scholarships as well. In the event a music scholarship is awarded, that scholarship will both *replace* and *increase* any other awards made by Brevard College, including academic or leadership scholarships.

Scholarship Opportunity:

The Brevard College Music Department is now seeking outstanding players for the Honors Woodwind Quintet and Honors Brass Quintet. These quintets serve as the musical ambassadors for Brevard College. Quintet members receive the highest possible scholarships, weekly coaching with a faculty member, and are regularly featured in performances on and off campus.
