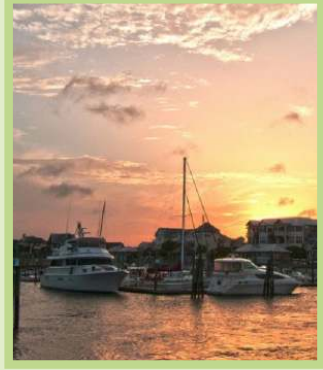
### Three-Night Bald Head Island Getaway
