**Faculty Position in Business and Organizational Leadership**

Brevard College seeks an enthusiastic teacher for a tenure-track faculty position as an Assistant Professor of Business & Organizational Leadership, beginning fall 2019. We seek a generalist with specialization in sustainability and leadership. A DBA or PhD in business with expertise in sustainability and leadership is desired. Candidates with an MBA and experience in sustainability and leadership will be considered.

The successful candidate will demonstrate the ability to teach courses at all levels of the undergraduate curriculum, including service courses, and will have interactive teaching skills to include experiential methods, active listening, appreciation of learners' questions, and the ability to stimulate critical reasoning and questioning. Teaching responsibilities will include business foundation courses and upper-level electives with a focus on sustainability and leadership, such as sustainable enterprises, innovation and sustainability in entrepreneurship, total quality, and strategic planning, and other courses in areas such as leadership practice and theory, human resource management, marketing, ethics, international business, and public relations. The standard teaching load is 24 semester hours per year—four courses in both fall and spring semesters. All faculty members teach and mentor outside the classroom. This includes active student advising; participation in the business colloquium; and advising the BC Business Club.

Brevard College, founded in 1853, is a residential liberal arts college. Situated in the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains, Brevard College is located 33 miles southwest of Asheville, North Carolina. Brevard College is committed to an experiential liberal arts education that encourages personal growth and inspires artistic, intellectual, and social action. Our faculty purposefully engage with learners in direct experience and focused reflections in order to increase knowledge, develop skills, and clarify values.

The starting date for this position is August 2019 and the position is contingent on funding. Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.
