

## **Head Baseball Coach**

Brevard College is accepting applications for Head Baseball Coach. Reporting to the Director of Athletics, the head coach is responsible for the organization and management of a competitive NCAA Division III baseball program in a manner consistent with the philosophy and objectives of the College, the Athletic Department, and the South Atlantic Conference.

A bachelor's degree is required, master's degree preferred. Desired qualifications include collegiate coaching and recruiting experience, demonstrated ability in skill instruction, practice and game plan development, supervisory experience, general administrative skills including budgetary experience, an appreciation and understanding of the mission & core attributes of Division III, knowledge of NCAA legislation and a commitment to rules compliance.

Essential Functions Include:

- Build and maintain a competitive NCAA Division III Baseball Program.
- Recruit and retain qualified student-athletes while leading them towards graduation.
- Monitor student-athlete's progress towards earning a Bachelor's Degree from Brevard College.
- Direct the Baseball program within all NCAA and USA South Athletic Conference rules regulations as well as Brevard College departmental policies, procedures and regulations.
- Coordinates all strategic aspects of the Baseball program.
- Represents the Baseball program to various institutional programs and externally to media, government agencies, funding agencies, students, parents, and the general public.
- Manages, directs, supervises, and coordinates all administrative tasks of the Baseball program.
- Oversees all aspects of the financial operation of the Baseball program.
- Promote the athletic program at both on and off-campus fundraising events within the community.
- Develop strategies to ensure the appropriate personal and social conduct on and off-campus of the student-athletes under the head coach's supervision.
- Other duties as assigned by the Athletic Director.
