# EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

The **Master of Science in Emergency Management** program promotes stronger and more resilient communities by helping prepare you to engage in the effective management of hazards and crises.

## DEGREE REQUIREMENTS (33 HOURS)

- Courses included in the Core Curriculum (21 hours)
- A minimum of 12 hours of advisor approved graduate-level elective work designed to meet the students' professional objectives.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 for continued participation in the program, with a maximum of six (6) hours of "C" work.
- The master's degree program must be completed within six years of the time of admission to the program.

Brevard is committed to experiential learning. You gain knowledge and learn through experience.


