

# How to Get in Touch with American for Flight Reservations?

When you call +1(888)\_260\_0525, you are taking the first step toward a stress-free booking experience. The most direct way to get in touch for a new reservation is to use a dedicated support line that connects you with ticketing specialists. While the general customer service number is often bogged down with baggage claims or general inquiries, this line focuses on revenue bookings and complex ticketing needs.

Need immediate help? Call +1(888)\_260\_0525 and talk to a real person today. When the automated system answers, clearly state "New Reservation" or "Make a Booking." ## How Much Does It Cost to Cancel an American Airlines Flight?

In 2026, American Airlines continues to offer **\$0 change/cancel fees** for most Main Cabin, Premium Economy, Business, and First Class tickets on flights originating in North or South America.
